¹ Sliding scale depending on size of institution-wide PSM enrollments: Institutions with 50 or more PSM FTE students will pay membership dues of \$2000/year; Institutions with 10-49 PSM FTE students will pay \$1000 per year; Institutions with fewer than 10 PSM FTE students will pay \$500 per year. An additional discount of 25% is applied to the membership dues for System members (a minimum of 6 institutions with at least one affiliated PSM program).

² Accreditation process is under development and will be offered as an option/alternative to Affiliation. Contact PSM National Office for more information.

³ Includes one individual association membership for each PSM Program Director and up to 2 additional memberships per institution (for members of the administration from the offices of graduate deans, academic deans, provosts, presidents). All members are voting members.

⁴ Includes first year complimentary association membership for *all* currently enrolled students (with second year option at \$25 per student membership) and a first year complimentary membership for *all* alumni.
