HISTORY

The Professional Science Master's (PSM) initiative began in 1997 with funding from the Alfred P. Sloan Foundation and the William M. Keck Foundation. In 2000, the Sloan Foundation began a partnership with the Council of Graduate Schools (CGS). This partnership focused on the expansion of the PSM initiative. The CGS team concentrated on PSM growth at master's focused institutions and engagement of university systems in addition to individual campuses. These Sloan funded expansion efforts continued through 2010. The CGS team also sought to develop a formal and sustainable affiliation review process. A stakeholder's group produced the PSM guidelines and designed quality assurance processes for the initiative. In 2012, the CGS and Sloan Foundation chose Keck Graduate Institute (KGI), one of the Claremont Colleges in southern California, to administer the affiliation review process. In partnership with the National Professional Science Master's Association (NPSMA), the Commission on Affiliation of PSM Programs (PSM Commission) works to build support for this historic initiative.

AFFILIATION REVIEW PROCESS

- Applications for PSM affiliation are reviewed by a committee of experts
- Affiliation renewal assessment of PSM programs is conducted on a 5-year cycle
- No campus site visit is held

 The Commission on Affiliation of PSM Programs conducts research on best practices, enrollments and degrees, and student outcomes
