What a busy month February has been for NPSMA Board and Committee members! The Conference Planning Committee have started planning our Annual Conference in Tampa on November 1st-4th, 2023- Please Save the Date! The Affiliation Committee is going through several re-affiliations of programs, some of whom have been with us longer than 10 years. If you have not yet heard from them, expect an email sometime in the next quarter. The Marketing and Outreach Committee are exploring micro credentialing, badging, and increasing our social media profile. In "Ask NPSMA," we have had lengthy discussions on several topics, most recently on Student and Faculty Wellness.

We have met with the Council of Graduate Schools, and will continue to do so this year, to seek guidance on restructuring / reframing proposed by members of our association. we individually represent and through our umbrella organization, the NPSMA.
